<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trauma Program Manager (TPM) who must be an RN and develop and oversee trauma program in collaboration with TPMD including creating policies, reviewing care, and Performance Improvement. 16 hours/week minimum to start @ _____/hour 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trauma Program Medical Director must be a physician. Will work with TPM to oversee trauma program, create policies, review care, and accomplish Performance Improvement. <i>Note: Hospitals commonly provide monetary incentives to the physician for taking on the responsibilities of this position.</i> 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trauma Registrar to abstract data from trauma patients meeting PTOS criteria (should have medical record abstraction expertise) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 30 min. needed on average per medical record ○ If 20 charts per month = 10 hrs/mo. x \$ _____/hr
