

Policy AC-106

Transition Period for the Implementation of New or Revised Standards of Accreditation

Purpose:

To provide a transition period for Trauma Programs to implement new or revised standards of accreditation.

Procedure:

- 1. Following approval by the Pennsylvania Trauma Systems Foundation (PTSF) Board of Directors (Board), new or revised standards will be made available to the pursuing hospitals/accredited trauma centers.
 - A. If a change eases the requirements for a trauma center, it is effective immediately.
 - B. If a change heightens the requirements for a trauma center, it will be in effect no less than nine (9) months from the approval date.
 - i. The Board may determine an effective date greater than nine (9) months should it determine a longer transition period is indicated.
- 2. The expected compliance date for the new or revised standards will be communicated to the hospitals in the Board Update and in Appendix E: Standards of Accreditation Revision Log in the Standards of Accreditation.
- 3. Pursuing hospitals/accredited trauma centers may apply for a variance from a standard based on Policy AC-105: Applying for a Variance from a Standard.
- 4. Site survey visits will be governed by the most recent set of standards with a compliance date in the survey cycle.
