Frequently Asked Questions

- Continuing Education
 - All registrants will receive an email with a link to a conference evaluation. Evaluation completion is required to receive CME and CE but not CSTR CE.
 - CSTR CE are available for both in-person and on-demand sessions. The certificate is posted on the PTSF Conference website for use by registrars to complete based on documentation of hours of sessions attended.
 - CME information is available at the registration desk.
- Photographs - A professional photographer will be taking photos throughout the conference. During breaks, he is available to do group photos in front of the PTSF backdrop in the Commonwealth Foyer. After the conference, photos will be available for free download.
- On Demand Access to Audio Recordings and PowerPoints
